

COOKIES POLICY

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are harmless text files containing small amounts of data that helps the website to remember information about your device and how you use the website. When you return to websites - or visit websites that use the same cookies - they recognise these cookies and therefore your browsing device.

2. Two Main Types of Cookies

(i) Session cookies

When you close your browser, some cookies are deleted. These are called session cookies.

(ii) Persistent cookies

Other cookies are stored on your device until they expire or you choose to delete them. They are called persistent cookies. These cookies are sent back to the Bank each time you visit the Bank's site.

3. What does the Bank use Cookies for?

Albaraka Bank ("the Bank") uses these cookies for different purposes, including: secure connectivity, letting you navigate between pages efficiently; remembering your preferences and generally improving your browsing experience and to provide a more user friendly online service.

The Bank does not use cookies to track people's Internet usage.

4. What type of information do cookies collect?

When you visit the Bank's website from any device (mobile, tablet or personal computing device), the Bank collects information about your use of this site, such as information about the device or browser you use to access the site, the way you interact with this site, and the IP address your device connects from. This information may also include data relating to your personal preferences, web and browser history, location data and device information which your computer or mobile device downloads when you visit the Bank's website.

The Bank will never save any personal information, including login details or other personal information on your computer.

5. Disabling cookies settings

You may not be able to initiate or complete some activities within the Bank's secure online services unless these cookies or similar technologies are accepted. Please note that the Bank may not be able to process certain transactions if you are physically located in certain countries.

You may disable cookies on your browser, however the Bank's website relies on cookies to enable certain functionality. If you choose to disable cookies, some of the services available on the Bank's website may not work properly.

If you've disabled one or more cookie categories, the Bank may still use information collected from existing cookies, but the Bank will stop using the disabled cookies to gather any further information. You can delete existing cookies from your web browser, however this may also limit your banking functionality.
